Scout Attendance Policy

Updated April 2018

Please note the following procedures are in place for applying to attend any Newport County AFC first-team fixture at Rodney Parade for the 2018/19 season.

Any club or intermediary wishing to send a representative to Newport County AFC fixtures must request permission by email at least 48 hours prior to any fixtures. Requests made after this point may be declined.

All applications should be sent to Head of Operations, Ethan Foster, at ethan.foster@newport-county.co.uk. Applications will be acknowledged with details by return email. Please note that the Club will not accept applications by fax, telephone call, text message or any form of social media.

Qualification:

Newport County AFC shall make scout tickets available to:

- Parent Clubs who currently have players on loan at Newport County AFC
- Clubs who play Newport County AFC in the preceding three matches
- Clubs who play the opposition Club in the preceding three matches

Newport County AFC reserve the right to amend these parameters of qualification at any time, and may accept other parties who do not meet the criteria at their own discretion. Tickets will be allocated within the Hazell Stand and are limited to two tickets per request. Parking at Rodney Parade is extremely limited and thus is not guaranteed with requests.

Expectations of Attendee:

- Upon arrival, tickets must be collected from the Newport County AFC Ticket Office, located in the main Rodney Parade carpark. Tickets will not be posted to attendees and will only be available for collection.
- Photo ID must be provided upon collection of tickets.
- Representatives are strictly forbidden from communicating with players during their attendance.
- Photography and videography are strictly prohibited during the course of the visit and the fixture.
- Attendees will adhere to the parameters set about in the ground regulations as per any other visitor, attendee or fan.
